I am pleased to inform you that the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) office in San Antonio has accepted the Williamson County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FY05 Annual Action Plan. The plan specifies the City of Taylor to receive \$400,000. The funding is to be utilized in the Dickey Street Drainage Project. The City of Taylor indicated that it will incur a leverage amount of \$100,000 for this project.

In order to proceed with this phase of the project (October 1, 2005 – September 30, 2006), please submit a detailed budget indicating how the City anticipates using the CDBG funds. I will also need a timeline that establishes milestones for this phase of the project. These items are necessary in order to produce an agreement between Williamson County and Taylor for FY05.


While the Action Plan has been accepted, Taylor is not approved to incur expenses against the FY05 funding until the following actions have occurred:

- Environmental review and public notification process has been completed by Williamson County.
- Approval of certification of compliance with environmental laws has been secured from HUD.
- Request for Release of Funds has been submitted to HUD by Williamson County.
- Execution of CDBG Agreement for FY05 between Williamson County and the City of Taylor.

Again, in order to create an agreement, a timeline and budget are needed. Please submit these to my office either by email or by postal mail.
