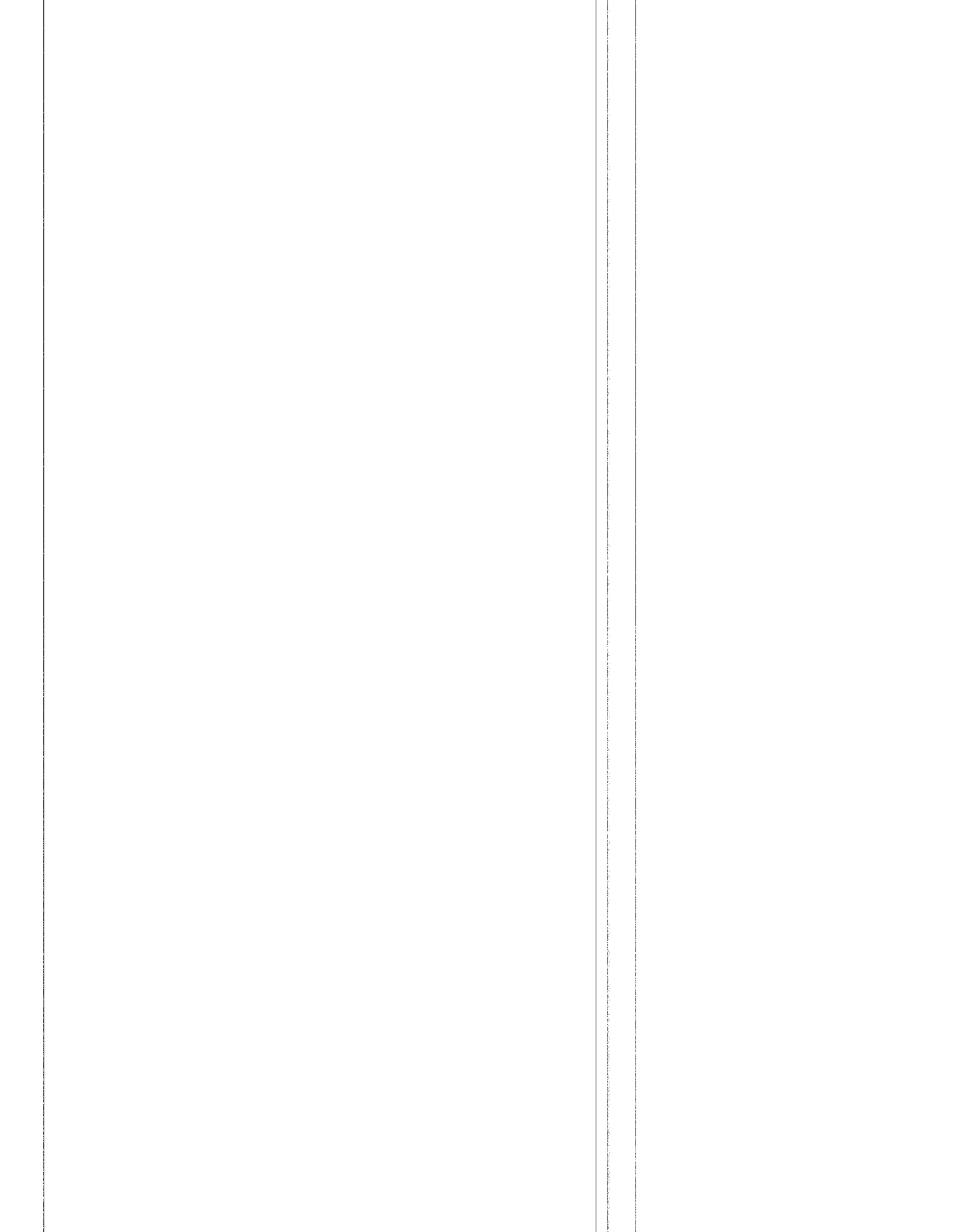
Thanks for considering me and allowing me an opportunity to serve the community as a member of the Zoning and Planning Commission. Please give my apologies to the other commission members.

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
