The County Commissioners' Court would like to thank you for your proposal regarding the 2004 Williamson County HUD Entitlement Program. As a part of this process, your participation has been vital to support the initial steps of our Williamson County program. As you know, benefits to our low- and moderate- income citizenry are essential for our community and continued collaboration is crucial to future program successes.

During this process, the County received 19 well deserving grant applications totaling \$2,442,798. Our CDBG current allocation for FY 2004 is \$1,215,000, which means some projects can not be funded at this time. Following a thorough application screening and ranking process based upon the County's Scoring Matrix, the County Commissioners' Court approved five projects for funding.

We are pleased to inform you that your project was included in the selection for this year. We will be contacting you with further details and when funding becomes available.

For your information, the approved infrastructure projects include 1) the Habitat for Humanity in Georgetown utilities and sidewalks, 2) the City of Taylor drainage 3) the City of Jarrell sewer system design, 4) the City of Leander drainage, and 5) the City of Liberty Hill Old Town sewer system design.
