Obstacles:

1. Lack of Council time and availability.

Solutions:

1. Budget and Expense account
2. Hire a Council Administrative Aide.

3. Staff to keep a calendar of all functions and schedule Council members according with their desire to work within organizations that they feel comfortable with.

ACTION

- Step 1: Hire Part-time Council Aide or assign staff for this activity.
- Step 2: Make a list of all Organizations that are potential resources for our citizens and Council members that could make Taylor a better place.
- Step 3: Council members to volunteer their willingness to work with people and organizations from the list generated in Step 2 and report back to staff. Report on what is going on Monthly? Quarterly? This could be facilitated by staff and relayed to Council. Staff members can prepare information packets for each Council member.
- Step 4: Make agenda items as needed for action by staff with all information provided.
